Jeff Coombs is remembered for his smile, his sense of humor and ability to make people laugh. An Abington resident, it was easy to see how devoted he was to his family, how proud he was of his three kids, and how much he cared about his community. He loved hiking, rollerblading, spending time on the Cape, and working around the house with the kids.

Immediately after his death in the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, our family was blessed with the kindness and concern of friends and strangers from across the country. The Jeff Coombs Memorial Foundation assists Massachusetts' families who face financial and emotional challenges due to death or illness. - Paid for and arranged for construction of a ramps for families with handicapped children
- Sent special needs children to camp
- Arranged social outings for grieving children

- Paid for grief counseling for children and spouses
- Granted more than \$50,000 in scholarships
- Funded numerous enrichment programs
